

**FACTS****WHAT DOES ST. JOSEPH TEACHERS' CREDIT UNION  
DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?****Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

**What?**

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and account balances, payment history, credit history
- and overdraft history, credit card balances, transaction history.

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

**How?**

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons St. Joseph Teachers' CU chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

## What we do

How does **St. Joseph Teachers' CU** protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does **St. Joseph Teachers' CU** collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- open an account or deposit money
- apply for loans or apply for debit or credit cards
- use your debit or credit cards

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

## Definitions

**Affiliates**

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *CSC Credit Bureau, Missouri Credit Union Association, Illinois Credit Union League (Debit/Credit Cards), Cutopia (On-line Banking).*

**Nonaffiliates**

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *The St. Joseph Teachers' Credit Union DOES NOT share with non affiliates so they can market you.*

**Joint marketing**

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *St. Joseph Teachers' Credit Union DOES NOT engage in joint marketing.*
